Public Postings Policy

Wood Buffalo Regional Library (WBRL) recognizes the important role the Library plays in ensuring the public has access to local information of a cultural, economic, or social nature.

WBRL posts:

- Information on Library programs.
- Information on not-for-profit organizations.
- Information on events supporting not-for-profit organizations.
- Information on cultural, recreational, and educational events.

WBRL must approve all postings. WBRL authorizes postings without regard to religion, sexual orientation, politics, or ethnicity. WBRL employees remove any unauthorized items.

To ensure WBRL remains a non-partisan, unbiased institution, the Library does not post:

- Information promoting commercial ventures.
- Religious information promoting one denomination or faith over another.
- Petitions.
- Information promoting political parties or individuals.
- Information aimed at putting people in touch with others, except in a support group capacity.

WBRL employees maintain postings based on space needs, and add and remove postings at their discretion.

WBRL posts information for programs held on the Library's premises at its discretion.

WBRL posts information sent electronically at its discretion.
